

Religious Education Programs

Children's religious education programs are beginning soon! Programs we offer:

Family Catechesis, for children in K through 6th grades, a program which involves the whole family in studying and praying together. Classes meet on Sunday mornings at 9:10 AM, and will begin on Sunday, September 11th, with a meeting in the church. Registration forms are available online or at a table in the Narthex. All registrations are due by September 11th. Family enrollment weekends will be August 27-28 and September 3-4.

Sacramental Preparation, for those in 2nd grade or older, meets on alternating Tuesday evenings at 6:15 PM, to prepare children to receive Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Holy Communion. (A separate class for older students who wish to be confirmed will begin in the late fall) Parent orientation begins September 13th. Registrations due Sept. 13.

Children's Liturgy of the Word, for children aged 3-8, during the 10:30 AM Mass on the 2nd Sunday of the month. A sign-up is available in the Narthex. (You do not need to sign up, but this helps to know how many children will attend)

Hitting the High Note!

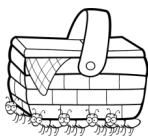
