Building Debt

This past week the parish received some very good news from the diocese. Celebrating the "Year of Mercy" called for by Pope Francis, the diocese has forgiven approximately \$55,000 of our building debt. This means after our February payment our debt stands at \$363,468.82. There is a 1 1/2% interest rate on that amount. The diocese encourages the parish to increase our effort at retiring the remainder of the debt.

I believe as a parish we also need to reciprocate the diocese's generosity by being generous in our pledges to the Annual Catholic Appeal.

CAPA also has a great need for new or gently used toddler clothes for their clothing room. The sizes most needed are 2t-6t, boys and girls. CAPA served over 380 families with clothing last year and their clothing bins are really showing it.
