All donations are greatly appreciated; however the items most needed include canned tuna, canned chicken, oatmeal, soup, chili, BBQ sauce, salad dressing, and cereal. Your donations benefit St. Margaret's Shelter and House of Charity.

In addition to our food collection, we will be collecting diapers and formula to benefit Childbirth and Parenting Assistance (CAPA). CAPA also has a great need for new or gently used toddler clothes for their clothing room. The sizes most needed are 2t-6t, boys and girls. CAPA served over 380 families with clothing last year and their clothing bins are really showing it.

Finally, we are collecting toilet paper for Summit View. Summit View is one of the affordable housing complexes operated by Catholic Charities Spokane.
