- Children's Mass Bags hang in the Children's Corner. These bags have religious books, laminated activity sheets, and saint holy cards for children to enjoy. Please make sure to return the bags to their hooks for another family to use!
- MagnifiKid magazines are free for the taking. Each month, pick up a set of MagnifiKids – one for each Sunday of the month. Each magazine has the daily Sunday readings, explanations of unfamiliar words, and the text of the prayers of the Mass. The back pages have other children's activities and a comic to enjoy!

Kneel or Sit after Communion?

The parish Pastoral Council met last week, and the question was raised about whether parishioners should kneel or sit after Communion. There is no preference; the primary concern is that after Communion, everyone assume a prayer posture that allows for prayer and reflection on the mystery of the Eucharist that we have all just received. Worrying about whether to kneel or sit, and then worrying about whether to sit after the Blessed Sacrament is returned to the chapel or to sit after Father is finished purifying the vessels...such worry is a distraction from the personal post-Communion prayer and reflection that is encouraged. So either posture is fine, and then the congregation stands when the Mass announcements (if any) begin, or when Father says, "Let us pray."
